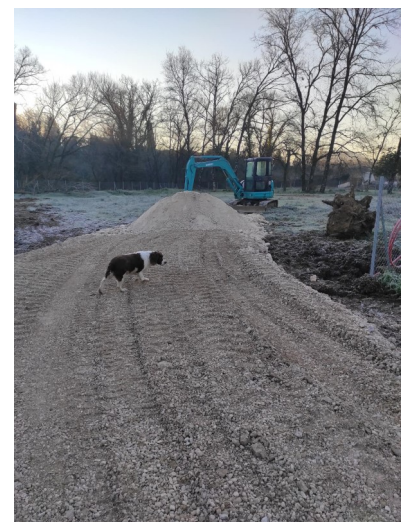

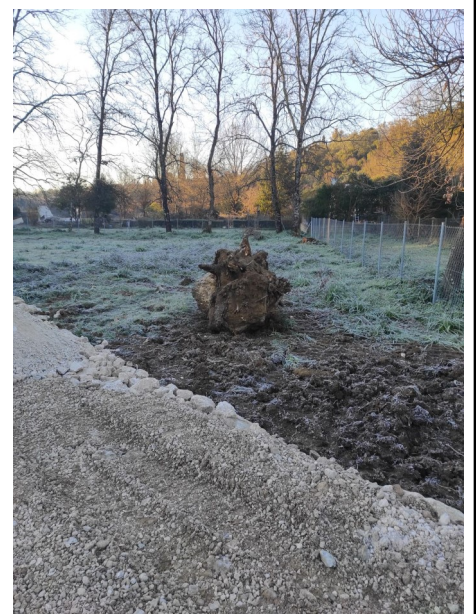

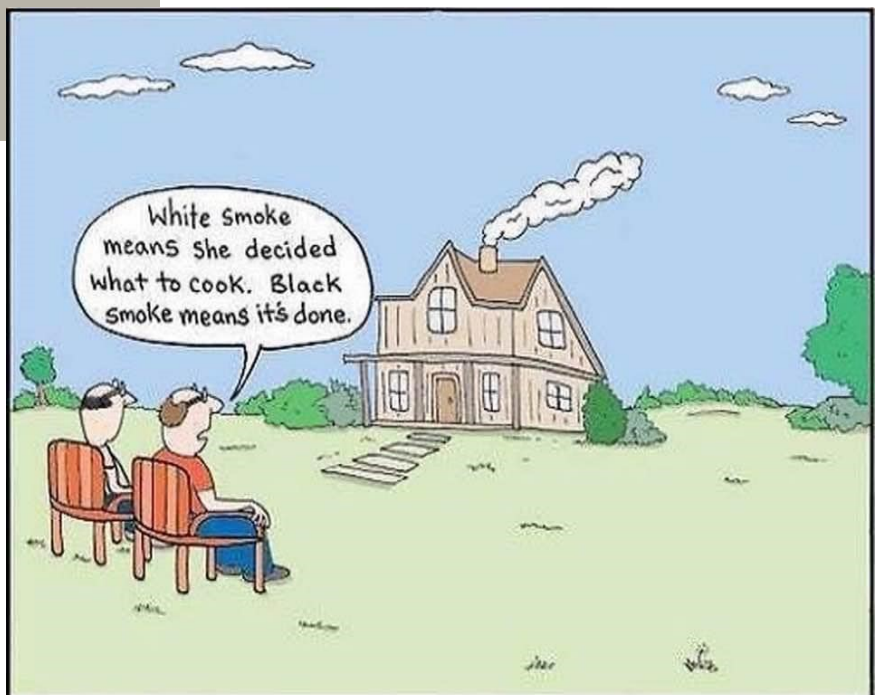

We're all going on a summer holiday

EVEN BEFORE I STARTED LEARNING FRENCH at secondary school, I knew what a boulangerie, charcuterie, épicerie and patisserie were. This was because, from the age of two, I was taken on annual summer holidays to France.

In the 1960s the food in England was still largely horrible, a legacy of wartime rationing, limited imports and a population of very conservative industrial urban dwellers. This, coupled with the constantly rainy weather we suffered in the north west of the country, prompted my parents to seek better conditions abroad. On the French Atlantic coast, the climate wasn't always terrific, but the food was better than at home.

With a daily budget of just a fiver to pay fuel, camping site fees, food and extras, we didn't eat in restaurants. In any case, tourist restaurants as we know them now did not exist - and if they did would have been wasted on us due to my weedy brother's dislike of almost everything except fish fingers (Findus only) and Kraft processed cheese, neither exactly easy to source in France. In fact, I only remember two occasions in those years when we had a restaurant lunch, one of them being an outstanding seafood and shellfish platter beside some harbour (the brother probably hated that, as I doubt my parents could persuade him that fresh clams and shrimps constituted the precursors of fish fingers). Instead, the car was packed with supplies. Camping gear on the roof rack; sleeping bags, air mattresses and clothes in the boot; and in every footwell, and under every seat, packets and tins of provender, to provide for meals throughout the three weeks of holiday. I remember a LOT of powdered mash and tins of ham - a proper hunk of meat in jelly, not the mechanically retrieved, pink-dyed product of today. Boxes of Kellogg's cereal of various sorts were squeezed in (the variety packs as they were less squashable), since French children didn't eat 'proper' breakfast as was our superior English habit.



As far as we could judge as onlookers, small local kids breakfasted on a big length of baguette, spread with butter and jam. One tot arrived with his 'tranche' at the campsite play park just as we were preparing to defend it against the French invaders. I had no memory of this, until my brother, the former weed, reminded me that I cuffed the child's hand upwards, causing la tranche to fly through the air, rotating around its length, to land inevitably jam-down in the sand. It was one-nil for England against the enemy team. We were horrible brats.

Lunch was the real treat, as it was supplemented by local fruit (I still remember those apricots, and the juicy Charente melons), and best of all, cakes. At a seaside village in the south west of Brittany (I won't name it as it is vastly changed), these were spectacular: Chocolate éclair for Dad; custard millefeuille for Mum; some sticky sponge for the Weed; and coffee éclair for me. I haven't eaten bought cakes since, because nothing compares. Nor does anything match the same bakery's croissants, bought just-baked from the premises (50 metres from the camp ground) and eaten as an extra breakfast snack. We would gradually unroll the flaky pastry and spread each section with butter, then munch down quickly just as the butter started to melt. I don't think they make croissants in a roll today - and as for the packaged ones, they're a criminal offence.

As a complete meal, picnics were best. When travelling between camping stops or tourist sights, we would stop in a random town at midday, parking under stately trees in the wide central boulevard (few cars were around in those days). Then we'd do the rounds of the various local shops - the aforementioned boulangerie etc; no supermarkets then - buying the unpackaged cheese and pate of the region, plus a couple of crispy baguettes, fruit and dark chocolate ('Poulaine' was the brand name I think). Then we'd head on and find a nice grassy verge; there was so little traffic that even main roads in the country were pleasantly quiet. Then we'd all plonk down on the picnic blanket and tuck in. The meal generally finished with the last rounds of baguette, generously spread with unsalted butter (only we Brits bought it salted, from New Zealand), each bite accompanied by a square of the chocolate, a sort of early Pain au Chocolat. This was more than delicious, but it doesn't work with anything other than French bread and butter, and that particular brand of choccy.

The local long-life milk we were obliged to pour on our morning cereal was horrid, though; I secretly envied those frenchies their breakfast tranche.



FOR A COUPLE OF SUMMERS, when we were growing out of buckets and spades as a means of entertainment (though my dad never did), we traitorously abandoned France and holidayed in Holland and on the Rhein.

Our ferry destination on both occasions was Zeebrugge, where we immediately sniffed out a super little cafe in a back alley. We fell on plates of Belgian-style chips - thin and crisp, unlike our soft and sometimes soggy chip-shop ones, and much tastier than the crinkle-cut frozen fakes we got at home - and on the house special, nasi goreng: Indonesian fried rice, spiced and studded with chicken and shrimps, and topped with a fried egg per person (the Weed was persuaded to eat it after my dad slyly invented a spurious connection to the Nazis and their general Hermann Goering; Weed was obsessed by The War).

Memo to self: Cook some nasi goreng.



ANOTHER COUPLE OF YEARS down the line, a teenager by now, we took a ferry to Bilbao in northern Spain (but left for France shortly afterwards as nothing was open and it rained constantly). I don't remember anything about the food - we had a motor caravan by then so no doubt our in-house meals were rather more varied - excepting one lunch in Vittoria, consistently voted the Number One Meal EVER AFTERWARDS by our otherwise divided family. We were having a coffee in the city square (uncrowded, traffic-lite) when my parents asked the waiter for his recommendation for lunch. He directed us round the corner to ... a simple bakery. It was nothing other than a small room with a hole in the back wall, in the depths of which the fires of Hell were burning, and into which the baker was loading bread with a wooden spade - a sight I would next encounter in Corfu.

In turn, a bakery assistant led us through a side door and along a maze of corridors, up and down narrow flights of steps, and finally into a vast barn-like space with a high-pitched roof, furnished with trestle tables and benches. We were the only people there. I guess if I'd been a bit more snowflakey, I'd have worried that no-one would find us ever again and we would languish there in perpetuity, unable to discover the way out. But no, within minutes a person arrived with a tray - a platter piled high with what looked like about half a lamb, together with a giant basket of bread, a carafe of thin wine and various utensils. The lamb, cooked in the bread oven we'd seen earlier, fell off the bone, and was not in the least greasy or stringy (or both) as it usually is here. The whole lot cost just under a quid. It was infinitely better than the local Basque tapas that everyone raves about nowadays.

PRIOR TO THE SPANISH EXPERIENCE, in 1969, we motor-caravanned to Czechoslovakia (I name the year because of its significance for that country), with the Weed staying back with grandparents, where he could scoff the mince, tatties and peas we never had at home. We had some connections in Bratislava and Prague due to a twinning arrangement with our local university. Because of the favourable exchange rate, and because my father stupidly performed illicit and illegal currency

deals in dark alleyways (smirking at his cleverness on each occasion, and not considering the danger of arrest and deportation or imprisonment if caught), we were able to eat out frequently. This was a pity, because everything we ordered turned out to be Weiner Schnitzel. Probably a way of disguising dodgy meat.

We were guests to a few homes, one of which supplied an evening 'meal'. One year after the Russian invasion, supplies would have been short, and we really didn't realise that. Only a couple of decades later, in Albania during the death of the Communist era, did I begin understand the hardships families will put themselves through to accommodate visitors. The Czechs accommodated us with carrot soup and boiled rabbit, I don't like to think of the source. I was used to neither, and during the night, for the first and only time on a family holiday, I was sick.

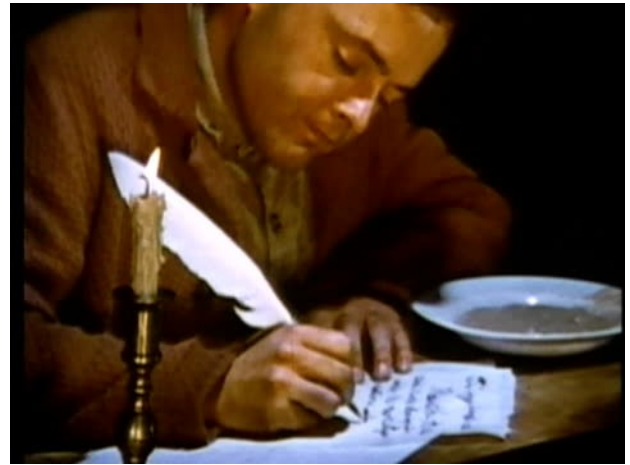
Letters to the Editor

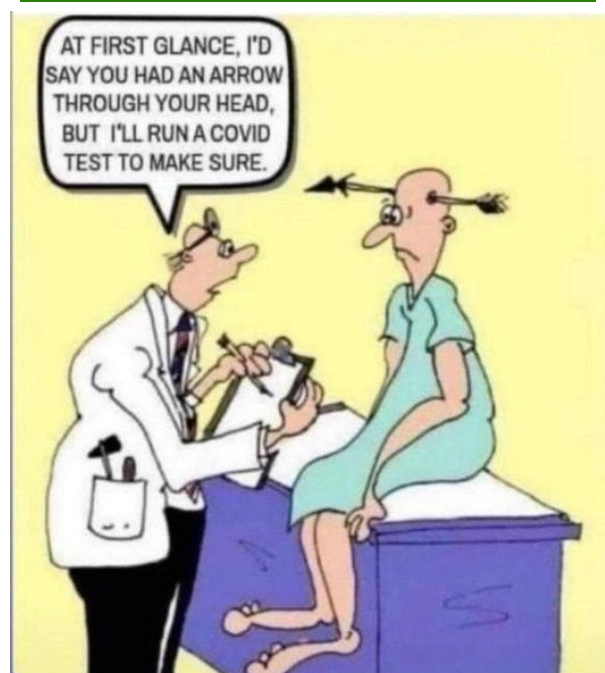
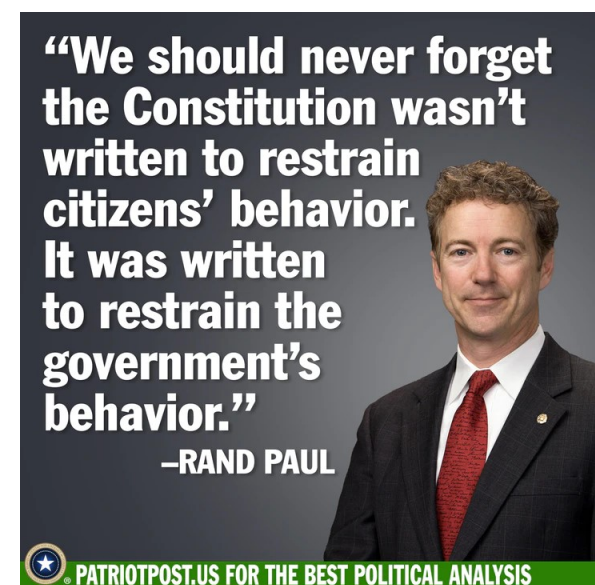
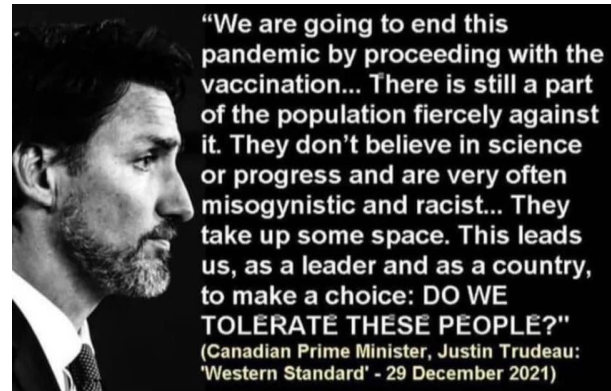
An enemy that will enslave us if we are lucky and kill us off, in time, if we are not.

Covid-19 Lawsuit Filed in International Criminal Court OTP-CR-473/21

The ICC has acknowledged the case and has attributed the following reference number OTP-CR-473/21. The defendants included: Dr. Anthony Fauci; Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, director-general of the World Health Organization (WHO); June Raine, executive director of the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA); Dr. Radiv Shah, president of the Rockefeller Foundation; and Dr. Peter Daszak, president of EcoHealth Alliance, as “responsible for numerous violations of the Nuremberg Code ... war crimes and crimes of aggression” in the United Kingdom and other countries.

Albert Bourla, CEO of Pfizer Stephane Bancel, CEO of AstraZeneca Pascal Soriot, CEO of Moderna Alex Gorsky, CEO of Johnson and Johnson, Boris Johnson, UK Prime Minister Christopher Whitty, UK Chief Medical Adviser, Matthew Hancock, former UK Secretary of State for Health and Social Care, Klaus Schwab, President of the World Economic Forum. After repeated attempts to bring a case before the English court system, the plaintiffs resorted to asking with “the utmost urgency” that the ICC stop the deployment of COVID vaccines, the introduction of illegal vaccination passports, and all

other types of illegal warfare that is being waged against the people of the United Kingdom who have been damaged.

AN INVITATION TO THE BBC

Mark Sexton Invites BBC And Sky to “Do Full Breaking Story” Regarding ICC Complaint - The Expose.

A few days ago, an update was published from retired police officer Mark Sexton regarding a criminal complaint filed on behalf of the people with the Prosecutor of the International Criminal Court (“ICC”).

On 2 January Sexton notified Sadiq Khan, Mayor of London, of the complaint and requested “all medical establishments cease administering the vaccines until further notice.” Since then, Sexton has been suspended from posting on Facebook ... again. So, two updates have been posted by ‘A Greater Britain’ on his behalf.

On Friday, Sexton contacted BBC and Sky, inviting them to break the biggest story in the last 100 years. This follows an update on Wednesday regarding the submission of 1100 pages of evidence to Hammersmith Criminal Investigation Department (“CID”) who “confirmed the crime report is now significant and very lengthy.” Text of Sexton’s invite to BBC and Sky: Sent to BBC and Sky at 6pm. (And yes, I know they are part of the system). It has to be done regardless.

Dear BBC URGENT.

I have also sent this to your what’s app news service. Are you aware of the live criminal investigation being carried out by the UK Metropolitan Police? Crime number 6029679/21. It is for Gross Negligence, Manslaughter and Misconduct in public office. Another 18 offences have also been cited including murder, fraud, GBH and multiple breaches of the human rights act and the Nuremberg Code.

If you would like to do a full breaking story on this I am in possession of the full irrefutable facts. It’s the biggest story this last 100 years, maybe longer.

The allegations, the evidence and those implicated are massive. This is a national emergency on the grandest of scales and as the leading news network in the world it is absolutely something you need to make the British public aware of and the rest of the world, as is your duty.

I also have the full information in the application to The International Criminal Court in The Hague. This application reference OTP-CR473/21 was acknowledged by The Hague on the 6th of December 2021. I am one of the applicants and informants to both of these very serious matters. Such is the seriousness and urgency to protect the public from harm I am happy to attend the BBC with all of the evidence to prove the above. All Chief Constables are now aware as is Sadiq Khan Mayor and PCC of London. A senior MP is also fully aware as of 9am this morning. I also have proof of this.

Two days before, on Wednesday 5 January, 'A Greater Britain' posted an update on Sexton's behalf: "Today I submitted 1100 pages of evidence to Hammersmith CID. 2 excellent detectives accepted and signed for the paperwork. They confirmed the crime report is now significant and very lengthy. A number of other world experts have added their details and support and again they were acknowledged by The Met Police."

Sexton continued: "There was provided a massive amount of evidence relating to the damage the v is causing. The Superintendent acknowledged Mark's submission." On Friday Mark Steele posted a video update on Telegram: "ACTION TIME IS NOW"

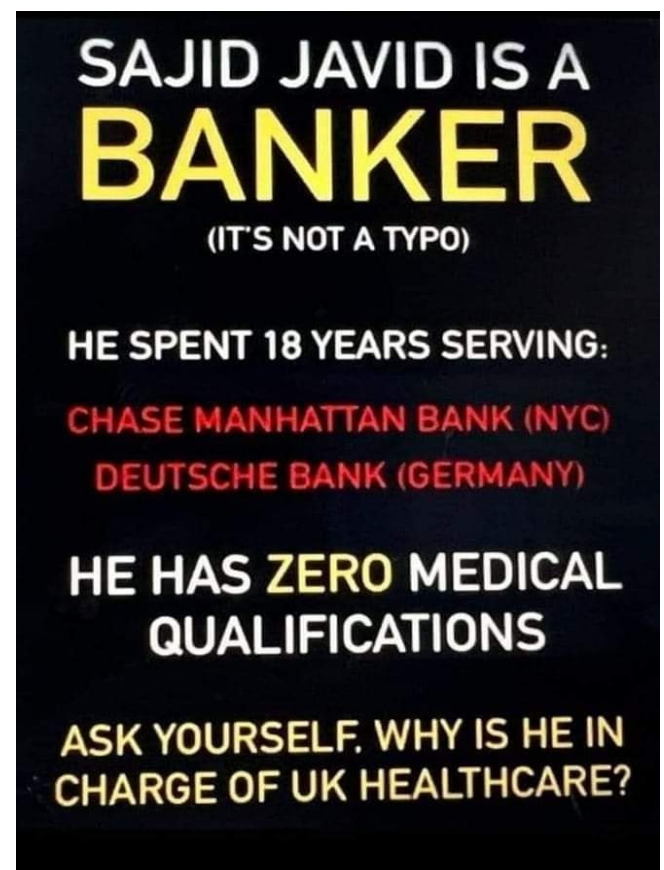
Sexton's update of 5 January 2021 continued: "Michael O Bernicia and his team have added their weight and support to this criminal investigation. The evidence they possess is vast and significant with regards to Midazolam and the deaths/murders attributed to this drug. Michael has emailed The Met

directly outlining the evidence they have and of the legal team he is working with. This is on the understanding his involvement in this investigation does not compromise the PCP he submitted to the courts on the 21/12/21." "We must get this criminal investigation into the public domain as soon as possible and the ICC application.

We need to be messaging the BBC and Sky News in the thousands to force their hand and air this to the masses, put pressure on the Police, stop the v and arrest those responsible ASAP. 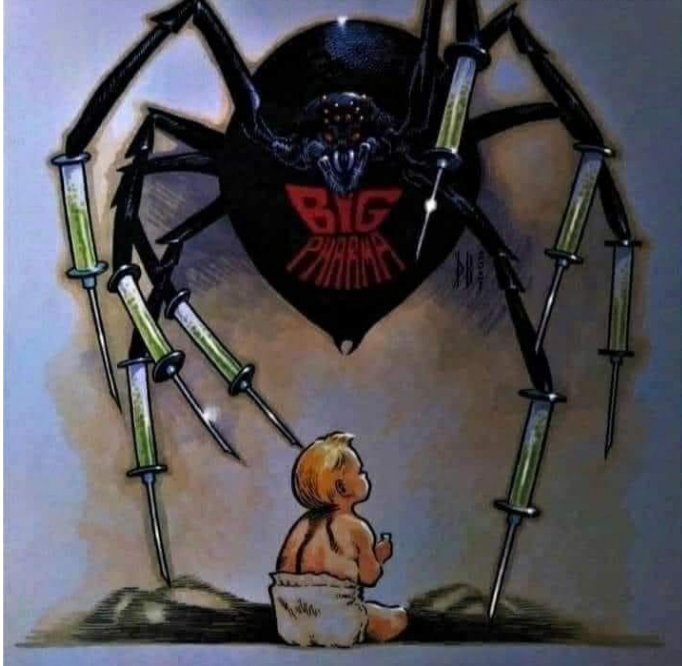

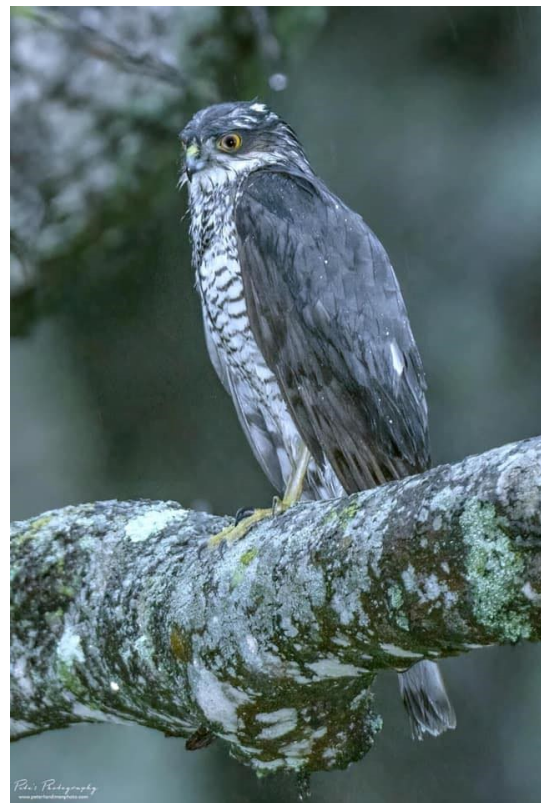

Amphibians and Reptiles of Paxos

Herpetofauna of Paxos, Ionian Islands, Greece, including two species new to the island Whereas the herpetofauna of Corfu, the northernmost of the Ionian Islands, has been extensively covered in the literature (see MERTENS 1961; TóTH et al. 2002; RAZETTI et al. 2006) only a few reports are available for the small neighboring island of Paxos or Paxi (KEYMAR 1984; ŠANDERA et al. 2004). Although scientific reports of reptiles are scarce, Paxos has been known to harbor many snakes and in one travel companion from the early 19th century (DODWELL 1819) you could for example read: "It (Paxos) contains vast number of serpents, which are said to be of harmless and inoffensive nature.". Paxos is the largest among the group of islands comprising Antipaxos, Panagia, Ag. Nikolaou, Mongonissi and a few other small islets or rocks. Paxos is situated 13 km SSE of Corfu and approximately 55 km northwest of Iefkada (Santa Maura). The distance to the Greek mainland is 15 km. The vegetation is typically Mediterranean, and the landscape and flora are highly influenced by centuries of human activity such as farming. In later years, tourism, house building and constructions of roads also have had an impact on the environment with degradation of the natural vegetation as a consequence. Approximately 75 % of the flora has a Mediterranean distribution in a wide sense (GEORGIADIS et al. 1986). About 435 plant taxa (species and subspecies) have been reported from the island and the forest is mainly of the Oleo-Ceratoneous type with species such as *Cerantonia siliqua*, *Pistacia lentiscus*, *Juniperus phoenicea*, *Pinus halepensis*, and *Olea europaea*, but tree species such as *Quercus ilex* and *Cupressus sempervirens* belonging to the so-called *Quercus ilicis* level are also represented. In the south of the Island a low-laying coastal level of phrygana vegetation can be found. Paxos has an area of 30 km² and a population of around 2,500 permanent residents. The average annual precipitation is similar to that of Corfu, i.e., approximately 1,000 mm. However, on Paxos all the natural water ways dry out completely in summer; there are no natural springs or water reservoirs in the ground and water has always been

scarce during the summer months. Old water-cisterns with small canals carved in the sloping rocks for the collection of rain water can be found in some places on the island, indicating that special measures had to be taken to collect and preserve fresh water. Paxos, Antipaxos, Iefkada, Cephalonia and Zakynthos belong to the Preapulian or Paxos sedimentary zone, a zone that corresponds to the most external domain of the Hellenic fold-and-thrust belt (KARAKITSIOS et al. 2010), while Corfu belongs to the Ionian sedimentary zone. The Paxos coastline is much eroded and boasts more sea caves per kilometer than any other coast line in the world (FRIEND 2002). The Preapulian zone has traditionally been considered a relatively uniform sedimentary zone consisting of limestone, dolomites, marlstone and evaporite, and the absence of flysch, but recent studies have revealed a more complex scenario (KARAKITSIOS et al. 2010). The topography of Paxos also differs from Corfu in the absence of high mountains and alluvial plains that are able to keep water for longer periods. The presence of both larger and smaller alluvial plains on Corfu makes it suitable breeding ground for amphibians that reproduce early in the year such as *Rana dalmatina* BONAPARTE, 1840, *Bufo viridis* LAURENTI, 1768, *Hyla arborea* (LINNAEUUS, 1758) and *Lissotriton vulgaris* (LINNAEUUS, 1758), species that all seem to be absent from Paxos. Previously published reports from Paxos mention *Algyroides nigropunctatus* (DUMÉRIER & BIBRON, 1839) and *Hemidactylus turcicus* (LINNAEUUS, 1758) (KOCH 1932), *A. nigropunctatus*, *H. turcicus* and *Lacerta viridis* (LAURENTI, 1768) (KEYMAR 1984), *Laudakia* [syn. *Stellagama*] *stellio* (LINNAEUUS, 1758) (one individual observed, SOWIG & SOWIG 1989), and *A. nigropunctatus*, *Zamenis longissimus* (LAURENTI, 1768) and *Platycephalus najadum* (EICHWAID, 1831) (ŠANDERA et al. 2004). During three days in 2013 (May 20-23) the authors searched the island for reptiles and amphibians. The weather was windy but in general beneficial, and five reptile species were observed: *H. Turcicus*.

Mediodactylus kotschy (STEINDACHNER, 1870), *A. nigropunctatus*, *Hierophis gemonensis* (LAURENTI, 1768) and *Z. longissimus*. No amphibians were found, and given the water situation of Paxos it is highly unlikely that amphibians have ever managed to establish populations. *Algyroides nigropunctatus* (> 10 specimens) - The Dalmatian *Algyroides* was the only diurnal lacertid encountered during the visit to the island. It is well known for its abundance on Corfu but despite generally favorable weather conditions they did not appear to occur in such high densities as on the latter mentioned island. lizards were typically encountered basking on the trunks of olive trees and on dry stone walls, and a couple of specimens were even found hiding beneath stones during cloudy weather. Most of the females seen on Paxos had a generally lighter brown coloration than those found on Corfu, often with a lighter colored chin. *Mediodactylus kotschy* (Fig. 1) (> 10 specimens) - This is a new record for Paxos and based on its close proximity to Corfu this find may further support the theory of the island's lineage in the Preapulian zone rather than having affiliations with Corfu. This gecko is already known from Kefalnia, Ithaki, Zakynthos and the smaller islands of Kalamos, Makri and Oxia in the Ionian Archipelago, although the subspecies status of the geckos on these islands is still uncertain (CHONDROPOULOS 1986). The authors only observed this species at two localities on Paxos, a small quarry on the edge of some largely disused olive groves where several geckos were found beneath stones and a dry-stone wall where a couple were seen diurnally basking. *Hemidactylus turcicus* (two specimens) - In contrast to its abundance across most of its range, only a few Turkish Geckos hiding under stones during the daytime were observed on Paxos. The relatively cold nights during the stay could have contributed to the lack of observations of this species around inhabited areas at night. From the authors' experience, this species, unlike *M. kotschy*, is scarcely seen active during the daytime in the spring months. *Hierophis gemonensis* (Fig. 2) (14 specimens) - A road-killed specimen represented the first record of the Balkan Whip Snake on Paxos. Half of the records were found as road-kills whereas live examples were

most often seen basking among densely vegetated edges of olive groves, as well as on dry-stone walls and olive trees. On two occasions feral cats were seen killing adult specimens of this snake. *Zamenis longissimus* (4 specimens) - Along with *Platyceps najadum*, this was the only snake previously recorded on Paxos. Elsewhere it is only known from Corfu on the Greek islands (CHONDROPOULOS 1989). From four snake specimens recorded, two were live and two road-killed. The first was found crossing the road in the late afternoon and a second was found dead on a quiet inland road not too far away. The further two specimens were very large. A male of 185 cm was found freshly killed on a busier road leading to Gaios and a female of 175 cm was caught near a water cistern on a cloudy afternoon. The size attained by these snakes could be related to the lack of competition from any other large snake on the island. Owing to its preference for mammal and bird prey items, it is plausible that many adult snakes on Paxos do reach a larger size than those where other more dominant colubrid snakes are present. The record localities of the reptile species are shown in Figures 3 and 4. The authors find it unlikely that *Laudakia stellio* is established on the island, and did not observe any *Lacerta viridis* or *Platyceps najadum*. However, the latter two could still possibly be considered among the herpetofauna of Paxos, especially considering that *P. najadum* is already well known from Corfu and small islets in the Ionian Islands such as Kalamos, Kastos, Karlonissi, Provati and Oxia (CHONDROPOULOS 1989). *Lacerta viridis* has only been reported by KEYMAR (1984) who found it in the phrygana vegetation zone limited to the extreme southern part of the island. The authors agree with KEYMAR that there are few, if any, other areas suitable for this species. A further two species, *Ablepharus kitaibelii* BIBRON & BORY, 1833 and *Telescopus fallax* (FIEISCHMANN, 1831) are known for their adaptation and distribution on the majority of islands in Greece, including some very tiny islets. This includes all of the main Ionian Islands and the small islet of Strophades, south of Zakynthos (CHONDROPOULOS 1989). These are the most likely reptile species to have escaped detection on Paxos.

Did lockdowns help to stop the spread of Covid-19?

The first UK lockdown ran from the 24th of March, to the 10th of May 2020 (indicated by arrows, Fig. 1).

On the first day of the lockdown there were 87 deaths and 8,077 active cases. If the disease were spread by contagion we would expect the numbers to begin to fall dramatically within a week, since the "incubation period" is considered to average "4-5 days from exposure to symptoms onset".

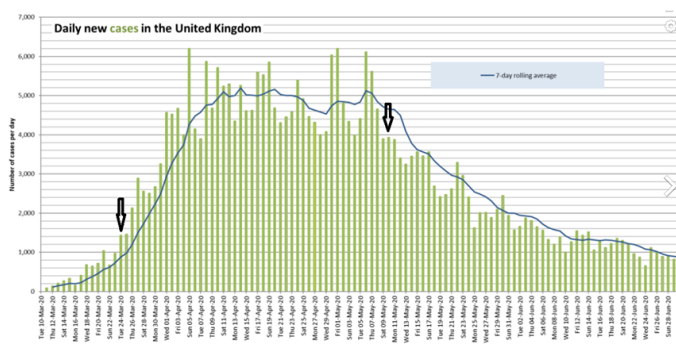

Instead, the number of cases and the number of deaths increased more rapidly for the next three weeks, until the middle of April.

On the 10th of May lockdown restrictions were relaxed and people went back to work. There were 210 deaths that day and there were 223,060 active cases in total – around 28 times as many cases as there had been at the start of lockdown.

We should therefore expect a contagious disease to have spread 28 times faster than before lockdown.

Instead, numbers continued to fall much more rapidly than they had done during the previous month and continued to fall right through to the end of June.

This would simply not be possible in an epidemic of any infectious disease.

This was confirmed by the Lancet in July of the same year in an analysis of 50 of the worst affected countries : - "government actions such as border closures, full lockdowns, and a high rate of COVID-19 testing were not associated with statistically significant reductions in the number of critical cases or overall mortality." What effects does radiation have in the environment?

The effect of ultraviolet light (UV) – the weakest form of radiation – on the atmosphere is somewhat complex and not fully understood. It involves oxygen, ozone, nitrogen oxides, hydroxyl radicals, formaldehyde, water vapour, carbon monoxide and methane.

UV and oxygen

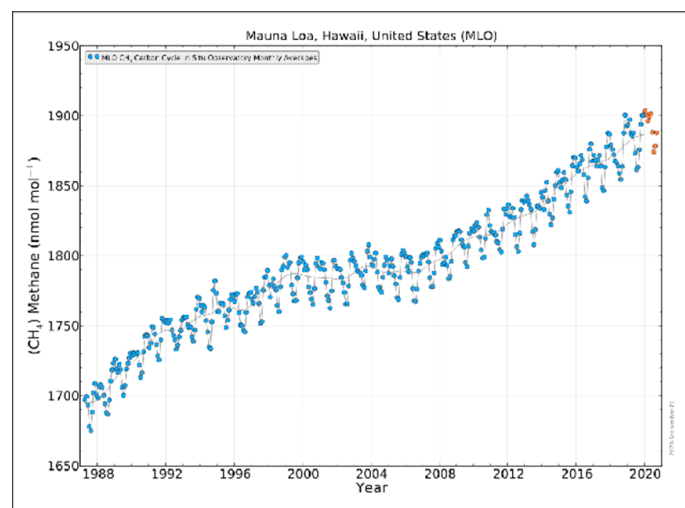
In the atmosphere, ozone is created when oxygen is ionised by the shorter wavelengths of UV light from the sun.

UV and methane

At ground level, most of the ozone is created by the oxidation of methane by UV. Methane comes from decaying vegetation, agriculture, forest fires, some volcanoes and melting glaciers, vehicle exhaust, power stations, melting permafrost, sea bed deposits of methane hydrate and from leaves exposed to ultraviolet light.

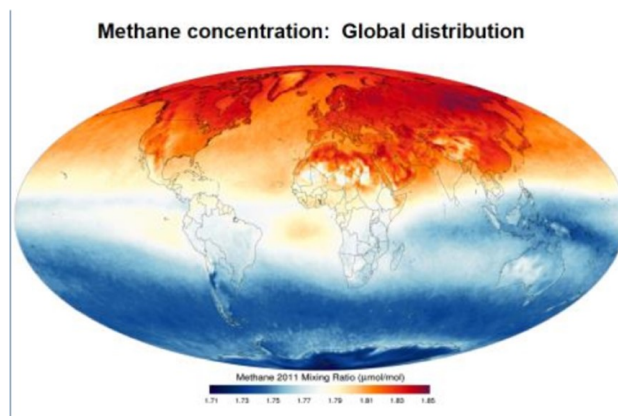
Both the amount of ultraviolet light and the amount of methane in the atmosphere have been increasing in recent times, resulting in more ozone at ground level.

“NASA scientists analyzing 30 years of satellite data have found that the amount of ultraviolet (UV) radiation reaching Earth's surface has increased markedly over the last three decades. Most of the increase has occurred in the mid-and-high latitudes.”

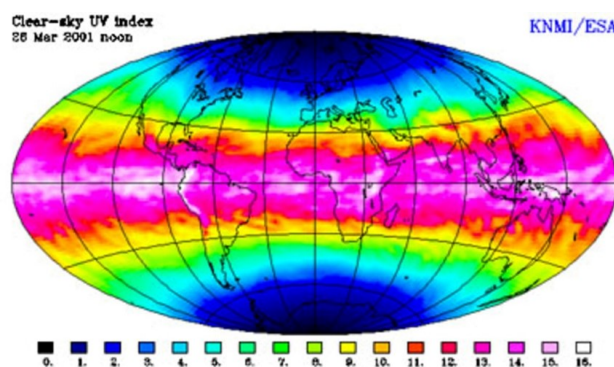


Increase in atmospheric methane over 30 years

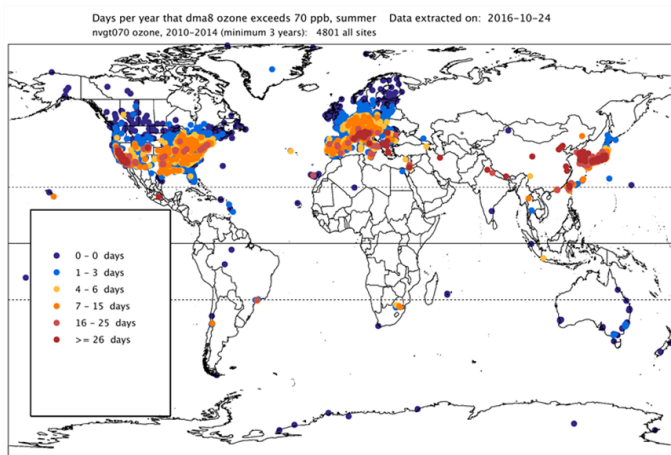
The methane is concentrated mostly in the north,...

Ozone concentrations are therefore highest in the intermediate zone.

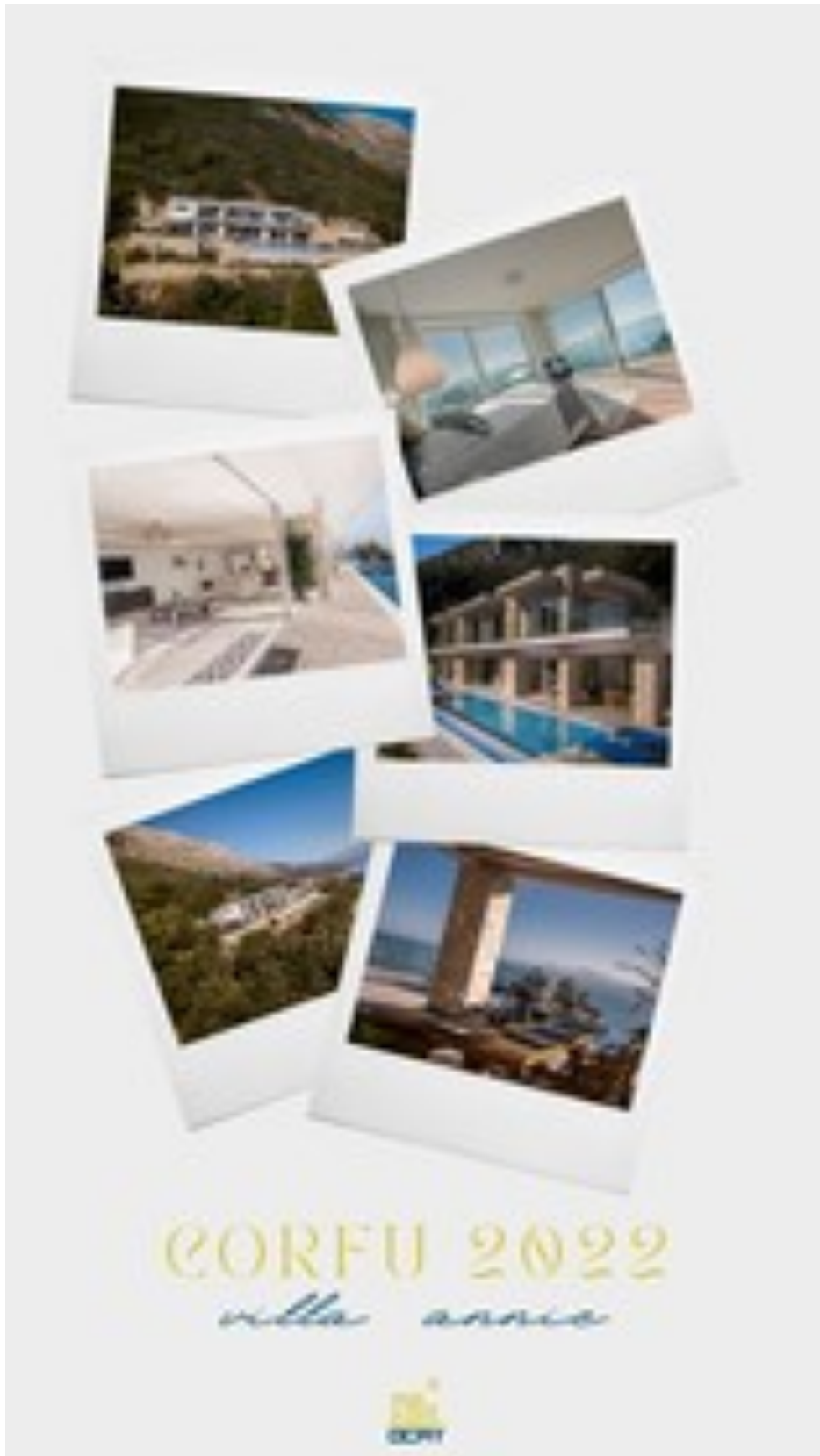


Ozone concentrations, 2010 - 2014

Power Outage....

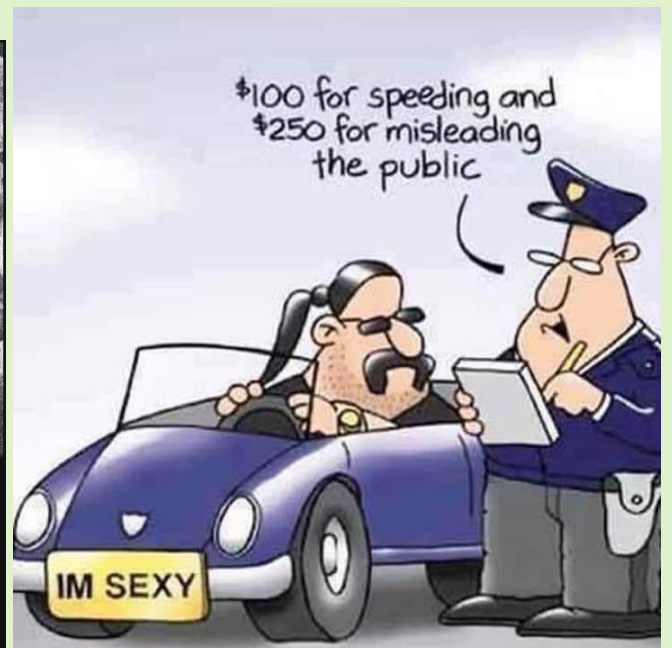

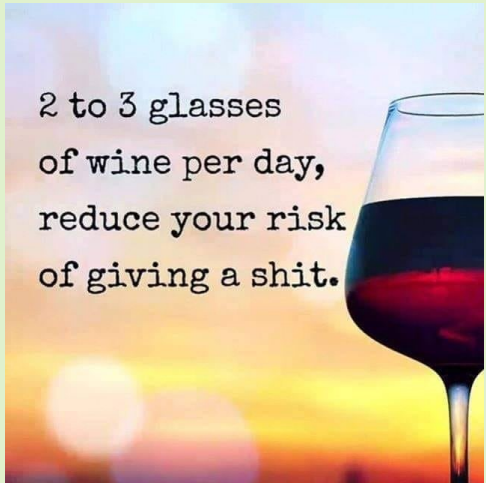

Anemone

A FLOWER CHARACTERISTIC OF FEBRUARY AND MARCH (but this year already blooming in mid-January) is the Anemone. When it opens, the flower is an intense purple, fading day by day almost to a pinkish ivory. About the name: It's taken from the Greek word 'anemos' meaning 'wind', a reference to the way the flowers on their slender stalks bend and tilt according to the direction of the breeze. Think about this Greek word when you pronounce the name and you are less likely to get it wrong - because many folk mistakenly call the flower 'Anemony'. I think this is due to the fact that we are more familiar with saying 'an enemy' than 'anemony', so we tend to switch the last two consonants.

Later in the season and higher in the hills, a second native anemone blooms. This is *Anemone blanda*, so called because its colour is less vibrant than its in-your-face-purple cousin. Actually, the flower is far from bland; its shade hovers somewhere between pale violet and sky blue. It's a lovely sight to see the two species growing side by side.
